

STAFF EXPERIENCES OF PROBATION SUPERVISION



What is this research about?

Hi - I'm Jan, a researcher from University of Nottingham. I'm part of a team who want to understand how probation/community supervision is experienced across the UK and Ireland. We are interested in the experience of supervising people in the community and we'd like to speak to Probation Officers about their role.

Why me?

You are a Probation Officer.



Do I have to take part?

You don't have to take part, but we would value your participation. If you want to know more, or you'd like to take part, we can have a chat and give you more details. We're also looking for people under supervision to take part. They can take part even if you are not.



What would I have to do?

If you take part, we will help you put an App on your phone. We will send 15 short questions over two weeks, like, "How do you find your caseload?" You can answer by text, voice message, or send a picture. After that, we will meet you for an interview to talk more about your experiences (about 1 hour).



What happens to the research?

At the end of the research we'll write a report. We **won't** use your name in any of the reports that we write. You can have a copy of this report.
